

ACCIDENT/ILLNESS

In case of an accident or illness, make sure one of our team members stays with the injured or ill team member. Please **do not leave them alone**. There should be a Romanian translator near by. They will assist you in getting word to a PIMI associate.

TIME DIFFERENCE

Romania is located within the Eastern European Time Zone (EET). The time difference between the United States and Romania is as follows:

Eastern Time Zone – 7 hours

Central Time Zone – 8 hours

Mountain Time Zone – 9 hours

Pacific Time Zone – 10 hours

An example of the time difference, when it is 8 AM in the Eastern Time Zone of the United States, it is 3 PM in Romania. (Romania's time is ahead of the United States time zones.)

HOST FAMILIES AND TRANSLATORS

Many times the team members will be eating lunch and dinner in the villages. Although PIMI provides the money for the people to purchase the food for the project, it would be a good idea to take items for your host family. Some recommended items are: zip loc bags, tablecloths, towels, dishtowels, vitamins for the family, plastic containers to store food, kitchen utensils, cake mixes, icing, rugs, mats, paper plates/napkins, flashlights, work gloves, batteries, etc. The families are very appreciative of anything they are given.

Team members grow very close to their translators. Some team members enjoy sharing items from America with their translators. If you would like to do so, some ideas are Christian T-shirts, Christian CD's and tapes, books, soaps, lotions, key rings, perfumes, cologne, baseball caps, etc.. As is stated in the team member covenant, **any gifts for the translators will be given at the END of the project, so as not to make the receiver feel obligated to give a gift in return or risk the chance of offending other translators.**
